




A - (1) One Left Indoor Receptacle w/ 32 gal. Liner SBA-2T32I-A

C - ( 2 ) Two Connecting Blocks RP-2T32-H


D - ( 1 ) One Connecting Spacer RP-2T32-S3

### 12 - #12 x 2 1/2" Pan Head Phillips Screw




Also needed for this assembly will be the following materials:

1 - #3 Phillips Drive Bit


#### \*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*:

- DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN SCREWS.
- USE A DRILL WITH ADJUSTABLE TORQUE FOR BEST RESULTS.
- OVER-TIGHTENING WILL RESULT IN STRIPPING OUT THE PILOT HOLE, AND SCREW WILL "SINK" INTO THE PLASTIC WHICH MAY CAUSE A STRESS FRACTURE.




#### Step #1:


Take Receptacle "A", open the door and remove the 32 gallon liner. Set aside. Repeat for Recepacle "B".



#### Step #2:


Take Receptacle "A" and place it as close as possible to Receptacle "B" (the sides without panels facing each other).





Step #3:


Align the pre-drilled holes in part "D" with the pilot holes at the base of Receptacle "A" and "B" as shown above.



#### Step #4:

Align the pre-drilled holes in part "C-1" to part "D" and the pilot holes in the bottom of parts "A" & "B" as shown above. After the holes are properly aligned, fasten with (1) One #12 x 2-1/2" Pan Head Phillips Screw per hole.


Note: Do not tighten screws completely, this will be done at a later step.




#### Step #5:

Take part "C-2" and line up the pre-drilled holes with the pilot holes inside Receptacles "A" and "B" as shown above. With the holes aligned, fasten (1)  $\#12 \times 2-1/2$ " Pan Head Phillips Screw per hole.

Note: Be sure to tighten screws completely after this step.



Step #6: Replace the 32 gallon liner in each receptacle.



Step #7:

Close the doors and secure each latch. Your receptacle is now complete.

\*Note: The receptacle weighs approximately 152 lbs., please use team lift when moving.
